Check to see if the motor is working by turning on the light if it has one. By knowing what the problem might be you can give the repair person a better idea of what they are coming out to fix. If you can be specific in what you need to have done you have a better ability to hire the right person for the job.

As with any construction or repair job the best source for good professionals are your friends and family. Get recommendations or warnings from people who have had a good or bad experience. Ask what they had fixed and how much it cost. Some other great places to look for recommendations are the Internet or the yellow pages. No matter how you find someone be sure to call and ask enough questions that you feel comfortable hiring them.

If you don't feel comfortable then don't hire them. Never give someone a shot because your friend recommended them if you aren't satisfied with their qualifications. The last part of a good garage door repair is maintaining it. If the motor got dirty and had to be replaced make sure to take better care of it.

Clean it off once in awhile and keep debris from interfering with its operation and be sure to keep all of the parts lubed and rust free. Remember too that if the repair doesn't hold you can usually call back the company and have them fix it again. Most good contractors guarantee their work for at least a little while. If you take the time to research and find a good garage door repair company you will be happy with the work they did and the price you paid.
